Lenape Day Camp – Special Education Teacher

Part-time seasonal position (8:15 am – 3:15 pm) for the eight-week summer camp season (6/25/18-8/17/18) and additional hours as needed. The Special Education Teacher is responsible for working with the children who need additional guidance and help in the Plainsboro Township Summer Lenape Day Camp (upcoming grades 1-6). Responsible for the health and well-being of the identified campers who need additional support throughout the camp day. Special Education Teacher will follow the direction of the Camp Director and will work cooperatively with the Camp Director and other Specialty Teachers to put forth the best possible program. Special Education Teacher will be responsible for putting into place individual plans for identified campers including but not limited to behavior modification plans, socialization plans, dealing with camper anxiety issues, and adapting activities for campers. Special Education Teacher will communicate to parents how child is doing throughout the camp experience. Position includes minimal pre-season work (mandatory staff training and camp set-up) as well as summer camp season. Special Education Teacher reports to the Lenape Camp Director. Must be available for the eight-week camp season.

The Special Education Teacher is responsible for working with the special needs children in the Plainsboro Township Summer Pre-K Camp (4-5 year olds) and helping them to adapt to a mainstream setting. Responsible for the health and well-being of the special needs campers. Special Education Teacher will follow the direction of the Camp Director and will work cooperatively with the Camp Director and other Classroom Teachers to put forth the best possible program. Special Education Teacher will be responsible for putting into place individual plans for special needs campers including but not limited to behavior modification plans, socialization plans, dealing with camper anxiety issues, and adapting activities for campers. Special Education Teacher will communicate to parents how child is doing throughout the camp experience.
